Presiding Officer Report — Nicholas Creel

1. <u>Feral Cats on Campus</u> Dr. Flory forwarded <u>an article from the Chronicle of Higher</u> <u>Education</u> about how university/faculty senates at other campus have worked to address the common problem of feral cats on campus.

2. <u>University Senate Budget and Foundation Updates</u>

- a. State account: \$3835.20
- b. Foundation account: \$93.75
- 3. ECUS Discussion
 - a. <u>Feral Cats on Campus</u> The committee debated whether this was an issue on campus.

Presiding Officer Elect Report — Stephanie Jett

- 1. <u>Election Oversight</u> Letters were sent to the Deans and Library Director on 8 Oct 2024 to start the elections process in the colleges. Election procedures will be requested from the Deans and Library Director by 1 Dec 2024.
 - a. Should Deans, Associate Deans, and Chairs be allowed to serve as EFS?
 - i. According to senate bylaws, if they are listed on the Corps of Instruction list, then they can serve as EFS.
 - ii. However, Given the extensive additional responsibilities of the aforementioned individuals as well as the power differential that exists between faculty and these CoI administrators, should ECUS/University Senate amend the bylaws to exclude them from being elected as EFS? What about serving as appointees?
- 2. <u>At-Large Faculty Senator Election</u> The next step for election season is to plan the atlarge faculty senator election procedure preparation including timeline (completion deadline March 1).

VI. New Business

- 1. **<u>BOR Policy Updates</u>** ECUS discussed the Board of Regents proposed policy changes. Nicholas Creel shared a draft of his letter to the BOR, and the committee made recommendations for revision.
- 2. <u>AI Issues</u>
 - a. It was noted that the Honor Code (Bobcat Code) does not mention AI while the recently revised Student Academic Dishonesty Policy does. ECUS will recommend that ECUS-SCC steer revision of the Honor Code to APC.
 - b. Since AI affects the scope of multiple standing committees (Microsoft Copilot appears to be a RPIPC issue, using AI to complete assignments appears to be an APC issue, and AI grading and teaching workload appears to be a FAPC issue), ECUS discussed the creation of a two-year ad hoc committee, constituted by members of appropriate standing committees and other relevant campus stakeholders, which would be devoted to recommending policy related to AI issues across the university.

1. In accordance with recent ECUS practice, the Chair Emeritus will review the University Senate Handbook for possible revision, and the Secretary will draft the Governance Calendar.
