Discussion Items

Proposal Review. Mary shared the rubrics the committee uses to review course and section proposals. She emphasized that the committee's role is to review whether the course meets the outcomes of the course, not the details of the syllabus. The rubrics are available on the committee's website and are available to faculty who are proposing courses.

Inclusion of Computer Science Courses in Area D. J.F. reviewed the current requirements for Area D: Natural Sciences, Math, and Technology. He noted that Computer Science courses are options only in the section of Area D required for Non-Science majors. The committee discussed what steps would be required to add Computer Science courses to the Science and Health Professions sections of Area D. The committee also discussed whether or not, based on each area's curriculum requirements, choosing Computer Science in those areas would create a longer path to degree completion for those students. J.F. agreed to write a rationale for the proposal to share with the committee at its next meeting.
