The College of Health Sciences Curriculum Committee met on November 9th 2012 to review and discuss the name change for the Health Education minor and the accompanying course changes proposed and sent forth through the Department of Kinesiology.

The committee recommends the approval of the name change to Community Health minor, the addition of KINS 3353 and the title changes for KINS 2313 and KINS 3333.

Re: Changes to Health Education minor

In Fall 2012, Kinesiology received USG permission for a name change from a B.S. with a major in Health Education: Concentration in Community Health and Human Services (CHHS) to a B.S. with a major in Community Health (renaming the former major of Health Education and removing concentration areas).

Due to the complexity of the proposal (interwoven with a change for Exercise Science) a name change for the minor in Health Education was not presented at the same time. In the interim, we have added one course to the minor (KINS 3353 Introduction to Environmental Health) and made revisions in two of the course titles (KINS 2313 Introduction to Health Education to Introduction to Public Health; and KINS 3333 Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases to Epidemiology and Human Disease).

Therefore, we are requesting from the Curriculum Committee approval:

1. To change the name of the minor from Health Education to Community Health.

And as an additional FYI where the minor is concerned:

1. We are adding KINS 3353 to the Program of Study for the minor in Community Health.
2. We are changing the titles of KINS 2313 and KINS 3333 (previously submitted with the major and already approved via the GCSU process).
