Change requests regarding Minors offered by the Music Therapy Program.

MAT- Physical Education Program Proposal:

I concur with the recommendations of the School of Health Sciences Graduate Committee in supporting the approval of the proposed MAT program. I urge an expedited review and approval since the USG has already recommended submission of the full proposal. As noted in the proposal, this program replaces the B.S. in Physical Education. The initiation of this program format will actually allow the academic unit to sustain and improve and already exceptionally strong teacher preparation program in a more teaching resource effective and cost efficient manner.

Our intention will be to apply for NCATE/NASPE Initial Program Recognition as soon as feasible. We wish to retain the national recognition we currently enjoy with this recognition in our now deactivated B.S. - Physical Education, K-12 Teaching Program. Following the model of GCSU's MAT Secondary Education, we are confident that we will continue to graduate exceptional quality Physical Educators who will lead the field as "Architects of Change" in Georgia's K-12 schools.

Changes in Music Therapy Minors:

I support the recommendations of the School of Health Sciences Undergraduate Committee regarding the proposed changes in Music Therapy Minor offerings. This includes deactivation of the Minor in Music Therapy and deactivation of the Minor in Movement Arts Therapy. Aspects of these two minors have actually been combined with a common core of required courses. Therefore, I recommend the approval of the Minor in Creative Arts Therapies. This newly designed minor will better meet the needs and interests of GCSU students as well as meet the AMTA & NASM directives regarding utilization of the term "Music Therapy" in a minor title.

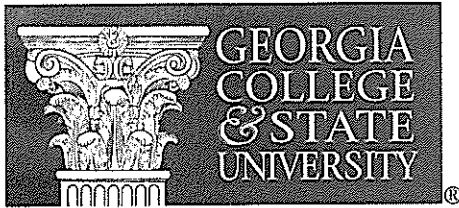

The Music Therapy accreditation agencies (AMTA, NASM) have deactivated nationally the title of Minor in Music Therapy. In compliance with the new guidelines, the following changes are requested:

- 1) Discontinue Minor in Music Therapy
- 2) Implement Minor in Creative Arts Therapies
- 3) Discontinue Minor in Movement Arts Therapy. Dance will be part of the new minor.

These changes will meet the guidelines for Music Therapy, streamline the minor to include Dance and create a more inclusive program that may meet more students' needs.

Students currently in the Minor in Music Therapy and in the Minor in Movement Arts Therapy will continue the current program of study. The new minor will begin for new students in Fall 2009 if approved.
