Thank you for reviewing significant changes that are needed in the Graduate Art Therapy Program in order to meet new accreditation standards set by both the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) and Accreditation Council for Art Therapy Education (ACATE). When the Art Therapy Program was initially developed, CAAHEP was not accrediting art therapy programs, hence the major changes that have developed since.

OVERVIEW OF CURRICULUM CHANGES

- 1. Increase the required number of credit hours in the Graduate Art Therapy Program from 48 hours to 60 hours as required by CAAHEP. Although this is a difference of 12 credits, approximately 4 courses, this transition is more involved than adding 4 courses. It is recommended that some courses are discontinued, some undergo name changes, and additional courses be added to meet all new content and competency requirements. Specifically:
 - A. Keep 2 courses that currently meet standards
 - B. Change the name of 3 courses to better represent the content of the course (course numbers will stay the same)
 - C. Discontinue 11 courses
 - D. Add 18 new courses

Outlined below are objectives, rationale, and benefits for proposed changes to the Graduate Art Therapy Program.

OBJECTIVES

- 2. Increase the required number of credit hours in the Art Therapy program from 48 hours to 60 hours. Although this is a difference of 12 credits, approximately 4 courses, this transition is more involved than adding 4 courses. It is recommended that some courses are discontinued, some undergo name changes, and additional courses be added.
- 3. Add one full time Lecturer / Internship Coordinator position.

RATIONALE

1. The American Art Therapy Association's quality assurance in Art Therapy Programs has, historically, been based on an intraorganizational approval process. Recently, the association has shifted its approval process to an outside agency (CAAHEP). Along with the shift came many changes; one being the number of credit hours required for program accreditation and how many hours of coursework are needed for graduates to be eligible for art therapy credentials set by the Art Therapy Credentials Board (ATCB) (See attachment: Appendix B in the Standards and Guidelines for the Accreditation of Educational Programs in Art Therapy). Aside from the increase of credit hours to 60, CAAHEP has very specific content areas that each have a set of very specific curriculum competencies which need to be assessed in the areas of knowledge, skills, and affect/behavior, that must be met for accreditation. Included is an outline of the courses that will need to be discontinued, names that need to be changed, and courses that need to be added to meet accreditation standards.

4. CAAHEP outlines specific job titles and roles (See attachment in Standards and Guidelines, Section III. Resources). It is quite clear that one full time faculty cannot fulfill the roles of Program Director, Faculty, and Practicum/Internship Coordinator while teaching 60 credit hours and completing the related tasks of the outcomes assessment, the accreditation process, and maintenance. Conversations with Dana Elmendorf, MA, ATR-BC, LPC and Chair of ACATE has advised and cautioned against using one full time faculty for these positions and maintaining accreditation. At least one more full-time faculty is required as well as the current part-time adjunct lecturer positions to meet and maintain accreditation standards.

BENEFITS

Aside from meeting the current standards and guidelines set by CAAHEP and ACATE for accreditation,
I believe the above outlined changes will make the Masters in Art Therapy Program at Georgia College
competitive and truly expand its role in Georgia's designated liberal arts university.
