Description and Rationale for Recommended Action (attach additional pages if needed, this description will be shared at all levels in the University, and the University System and SACS Offices): Due to a historical pattern of low enrollment and graduation rates over the past 10 years, as well as a failure to achieve programmatic and administrative goals assembled from comprehensive program reviews and yearly progress and planning reports, we are recommending the B.S. in Outdoor Education be deactivated effective January 1, 2017. There are six students who have declared this major for 2016-2017. These students, in addition to those currently in the program, will be given the opportunity to progress to graduation and earn the degree. We will phase out the program with each year of graduates as we do the final "teach out." We will also stop admitting students into the major at the time we deactivate.
